Applications should be sent by post or delivered by hand at Mzuzu University Campus in the Registry.

Applications should be submitted with an admission application fee of **K10,000.00** for Malawian applicants and US\$150 for international applicants. Applications submitted without the admission application fee will be disqualified. Please note that the admission application fee is non-refundable.
